## Policy Enforcement Capabilities

### Pre-Send Interception of Non-compliant Messages

- Stop non-compliant emails before they are sent reducing risk and limiting liability from unauthorized activities.
- Intercept messages breaching corporate policies including control of confidential information or acceptable use.
- Active Intervention holds the message prior to send for user confirmation

### Monitoring & Review

- Analyze activity and understand types and degrees of non-compliant behavior.
- Review suspect e-mails and approve for release to be sent as intended.

### Attachment Analysis

- Apply policies to the content and characteristics of attachments in addition to the body text of an e-mail.

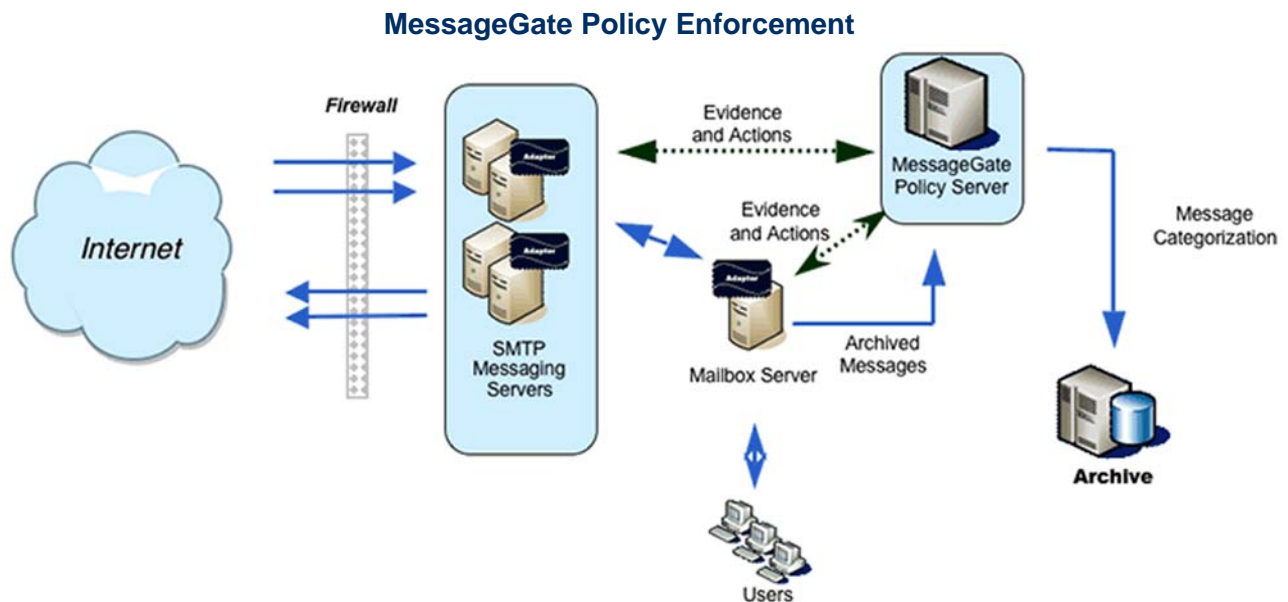
## Examples of Policy Enforcement In Use

*Acceptable Use* – policies related to what information can be shared with whom including prohibition of inappropriate and/or offensive content, restrictions on file size, and controls on recipients.

*Proprietary Information* – policies that control the inadvertent or intentional release of sensitive or confidential documents and correspondence ensuring proper Information Leakage Prevention (ILP).

*Trade Secrets* – policies that protect trade secrets and other forms of intellectual property from being inadvertently or intentionally sent outside the company via the corporate email system.

*Identity Theft* – policies designed to detect suspicious behaviors related to personal financial information and other forms of account and personal identifiers.
